THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE WORLD ACADEMY OF COSMETIC SURGERY WELCOMES YOU TO OUR SECOND ANNUAL MEETING IN VIENNA FROM SEPTEMBER 1-4TH 2011.

Less than a year ago, an international group of well-established cosmetic surgeons recognised the need for an *international multidisciplinary organisation* and thus created the WAOCS.

After initial elections, by-laws and code of ethics were adopted. The WAOCS has been registered in Switzerland as a non-profit organisation with the simple goals of promoting cosmetic surgery and defining standards of care.

We all firmly believe in the necessity of a multidisciplinary approach to cosmetic surgery. Patient safety, as an ultimate goal, can only be insured by improving doctors training. Since cosmetic procedures are not carried out routinely in public or teaching hospitals, the need for well-structured private organisations becomes evident. In less than one year, the WAOCS has been able to introduce **Board Exams for Cosmetic Surgery**: the equivalent of other exams to obtain board certification in different established specialities. This is a huge step towards improving quality of care and establishing minimum standards in this field.

The first Board Review Course was held prior to the 2nd annual meeting from August 30-31, 2011 at Vienna Marriott Hotel.

The review course offers an intensive preparation for board exams to be held December 4th, 2011 in Tyrol, Austria.

Join the World Academy for the benefits of our patients and let us share our passion and energy in this exciting development.

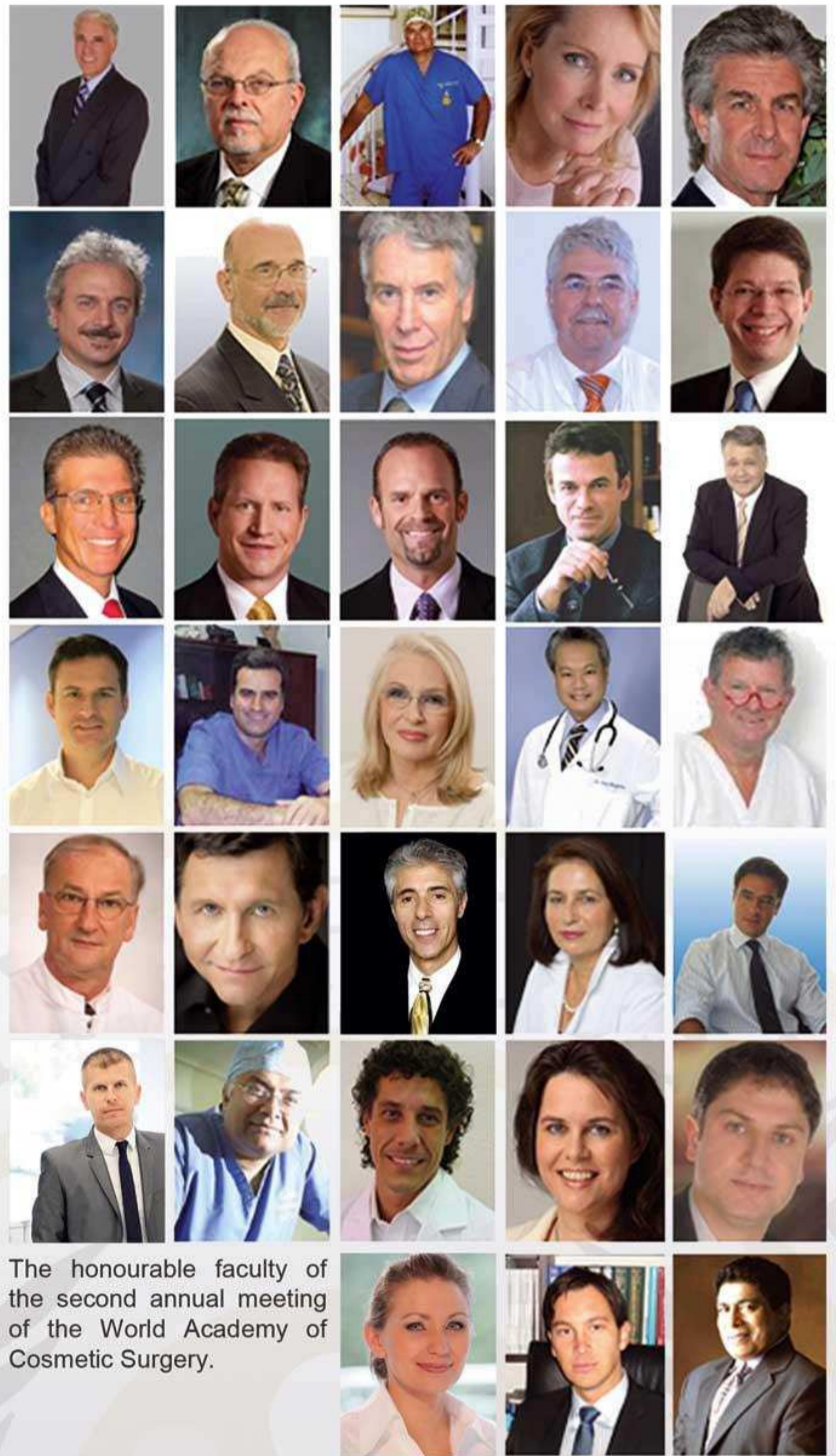

KARL KOLLER AWARD



Carl Koller, 1857 - 1944

Koller worked at the University Hospital of Vienna after his medical studies. At the suggestion of Sigmund Freud, Koller discovered that a few drops of cocaine solution eliminated the problems of eye reflexes. Koller is therefore considered the founder of local anesthesia in ophthalmology.

As he was constantly experimenting with cocaine, Sigmund Freud gave him the nickname "Coca-Koller". Koller was nominated several times for the Nobel Prize in Physiology and Medicine. The Austrian Academy of Cosmetic Surgery initiated the "Karl Koller Award" to be presented for outstanding contributions in the field of local anaesthesia. Dr. Gerhard Sattler, a former recipient, will present the "Karl Koller Award".
